

What is it?

The Derwood Open is the annual charity golf tournament organized by the Mill Creek Parish United Methodist Church. Held at Laytonsville Golf Course, the tournament brings together around 100 golfers for golf, food, gifts and fun.



This is the tournament's 15th year – thanks to our golfers and local businesses like you we have raised over \$160,000 in the first 13 years. The money raised supports the community service projects of the Mill Creek Parish Youth and 2 separate weeks of summer camp for local kids.

The largest of the community service projects is the Appalachia Service Project – our youth travel to WV, KY, VA and TN to help repair homes and befriend families who live in conditions we can only imagine. MCP Youth have been assisting in this region for 40 years. The other community service project is with Group Mission Trips – our youth travel to eastern cities to complete projects on the homes of the neediest families in the community.

Camp Hope – a week of summer camp for local kids with incarcerated parents. This camp helps break the cycle where children of incarcerated parents are 7 times more likely to become negatively involved with the criminal justice system.

Pivot Basketball Camp – a week of summer camp for local under-served middle and high school kids, using basketball to establish relationships and mentoring.
